Job Description

OVERVIEW

Kiribati, officially the Republic of Kiribati, is a sovereign state in Micronesia in the central Pacific Ocean. The permanent population is just over 110,000 (2015), more than half of whom live on Tarawa Atoll. The state comprises 32 atolls and reef islands and one raised coral island, Banaba.

Air Kiribati Limited is the national airline of Kiribati operating passenger services within the Gilbert Islands of Kiribati, and within the Line Islands. It also utilises other international airlines to assure regular air services into and out of Bonriki. It also operates charters, medical evacuation and search and rescue services. Its main base is Bonriki International Airport, Tarawa Atoll.

Air Kiribati currently operates 2 DHC-6 Aircraft, 2 Y12 (one of which is positioned on Kiritmati Island) and one Dash 8 100 series aircraft. With the support from the Government of Kiribati has decided to enter into international jet operations, operating a fleet of 2 Embraer 190 E2 aircraft. With the first aircraft due to arrive in December 2019. This will form the nucleus of its international operations.

As such the airline is currently undergoing a process of institutional strengthening to allow the carrier to take on greater levels of domestic and international services.

POSITION OBJECTIVES

The Fleet and Check and Training Captain for Air Kiribati's DHC-6 and Y12 fleet is a senior position within our Flight Operations Department. Working with a group of committed and enthusiastic crew, the Fleet and Check and Training Captain will work to strengthen the operations of the DHC-6 and Y12 fleet while also providing specialized technical and procedural matters as detailed for assessment of pilots' readiness for a competency checks.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Key responsibilities include:

- Carries out all duties assignable to a Training Captain
- Carries out flight training to the approved type rating syllabus and standard.
- Carries out aircraft conversion training, if required, to the approved type rating syllabus and standard.
- Other duties associated with training if required such as Carries out cockpit procedures training instruction.
- Records all training results as required by the Training and Standards

Manual.

- Ensure pilots under training become familiar with standard operating procedures by carrying out the contents of the line training syllabus and recommending them for a final route check.
- Ensures First Officers who have been selected for command are thoroughly briefed and trained according to the command training syllabus and recommending them for a final command route check.
- Briefs pilots for route and aerodrome familiarization purposes where required (restricted to aerodromes, areas and/or routes for which the approved person holds a current qualification).
- Carries out special projects as detailed from time to time by the Training Manager.
- Records all training results as required by this manual.
- Carry out ground school for new pilots if required
- Provides feedback to the GM Flight Operations on operational, HR and
- Other duties as requested by the GM Flight Operations, CEO and Board.
